
St. Paul's is located in the residential community of Riverside in the Town of Greenwich, Connecticut. From the Long Island Sound to the wooded countryside, Greenwich has amazing recreational opportunities from hiking, kayaking to swimming. Greenwich is home to some of the best public schools in Connecticut. Greenwich is also a center for local cultural activities, plus with one-hour train trip to New York City we are in proximity to one of the most culturally diverse, vibrant cities in the world.

The church's campus, on nearly 9 acres, provides space for St. Paul's preschool, the church, a neighborhood playground, memorial garden and a large open meadow. We have a new congregational garden providing fresh produce to a local immigration program and beehives producing abundant honey. We support local not-for-profits by making dinners for a transitional housing facility, monthly food donations to a food pantry and regular donations to help seasonal efforts.

- * Share in the preaching and the liturgical, sacramental and pastoral care of the church.
- * Assist the lay lead new member's "Invite, Welcome, Connect" program to integrate newcomers into the life of our congregation.
- * Support the congregation's outreach and evangelism to our community and the world through partnership with local groups, participation in mission programs, and identifying other opportunities to carry the Gospel message into the world.
- * Actively participate in monthly vestry meetings, weekly staff meetings, diocesan events and the Greenwich Clergy Fellowship.
- * Teach occasional Adult Sunday school class and Bible Study. Lead Confirmation and Inquirer's Class.
